Sheldon Cooper Roommate Agreement

- Skynet clause (<u>The Cooper-Nowitzki Theorem</u>) Sets out what happens if one friend needs help to destroy an artificial intelligence he's created that's taking over Earth
- Body Snatches clause (<u>The Cooper-Nowitzki Theorem</u>) Specifies what happens if one friend needs help to destroy someone they know who's been replaced with an alien pod
- Godzilla clause (<u>The Cooper-Nowitzki Theorem</u>) What happens if someone threatens to destroy Tokyo
- Over-night guests notification clause (<u>The Irish Pub Formulation</u>) There has to be a 24-hour notice if a non-related female is staying over night
- Article One, Section Three Sheldon calls an emergency meeting in <u>The Vartabedian</u> Conundrum
- Section 7, Subsection B (<u>The Agreement Dissection</u>) Number 9 "The right to bathroom privacy is suspended in the event of force majeure." Also, the shower can have at most one occupant, except in the event of an attack by water-soluble aliens.

- Section "Television & Movies" (<u>The Staircase Implementation</u>) Roommates agree that Friday nights shall be reserved for watching Joss Whedon's brilliant new series Firefly.
- Section 9, "Miscellany" (<u>The Staircase Implementation</u>) The apartment's flag is a gold lion rampant on a field of azure and should never fly upside down, unless the apartment is in distress. Also, if one of the roommates ever masters time travel, he should has to appear in the apartment exactly five seconds after the clause was signed.
- Section 37B, Miscellaneous Duties (<u>The Friendship Contraction</u>): Leonard is obligated to drive Sheldon to his various appointments, such as the dentist. He must also provide a "confirmation sniff" for questionable dairy products.
- Section 74, C (<u>The Cruciferous Vegetable Amplification</u>) The obligations and duties of the parties in the event one of them becomes a robot.
- Addendum J (<u>The Agreement Dissection</u>) "When Sheldon showers second, any and all measures shall be taken to ensure an adequate supply of hot water.
- Clause 209 (<u>The Friendship Contraction</u>) Gives either party the option of suspending their friendship and stripping the roommate agreement down to its bare essentials. Their responsibilities to each other would only be rent, utilities and a perfunctory chin jut of recognition as they pass in the hall.
- "Leonard's Day Addendum" (<u>The Friendship Contraction</u>) "In the spirit of Mother's Day or Father's Day, once a year, we set aside day to celebrate all your contributions to my life, both actual and imagined by you. We could call it Leonard's Day."
- Section 27, Paragraph 5 (<u>The Spoiler Alert Segmentation</u>) The roommate agreement, like the American flag, cannot touch the ground.

Unspecified Clauses

- Leonard has the right to allocate fifty percent of the cubic footage of the common areas, but only if Sheldon is notified in advance by e-mail. (<u>The Staircase</u> Implementation)
- "Pets are banned under the roommate agreement, with the exception of service animals" like cybernetically-trained helper monkeys. (The Plimpton Stimulation)
- Thursday night's are Franconi's Pizza nights. Also, the selection of a new take-out restaurant requires public hearings and a 60-day comment period. (<u>The Agreement Dissection</u>)
- Sheldon will be Leonard's sidekick should he ever get superpowers. (<u>The Vartabedian</u> Conundrum)
- If one of them gets the opportunity to visit the CERN Super Collider, they must take the other roommate along. (The Large Hadron Collision)
- Sheldon will take Leonard swimming to Bill Gates' house if he is ever invited. (<u>The Large Hadron Collision</u>)
- When the roommates vote on matters, Sheldon decides all ties. (The Staircase Implementation)
